CLS GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE PROJECT



Cambridge Lower Secondary Grade 8 Global prospective students were given the assignment of examining and gathering information on Mahatma Gandhi or Nelson Mandela. In addition to describing the facts, the focus was on assessing and forming an opinion about these great leaders, their legacy and impact. Because they were put to the test after each presentation, the session was very interesting. The process improved their ATL abilities, particularly in the areas of "critical analysis" and "communication"

Ashini Sheoran, a student in the IBDP program at G.D. Goenka World School, is participating in the IBx Initiative with Aliza Fattani, an IB graduate student from the United Arab Emirates, and Sofia May, a supervisor from Indonesia. Every IB student goes through a process that takes two months to gather materials that will help them in their chosen subjects. Current techniques for asset sharing (like Reddit) are profoundly hazardous as it is impossible to order the significance of every asset with an over-the-top sum accessible.

Not to mention the promotional content that is given priority. We're settling it through quester! Quester is a tool for curating digital content. We are creating the largest-ever IB library by utilizing quester. Consider this: a single location for every IB subject study guide, exemplar IA/EE, core resource, YouTube video, past paper, and question bank! The problem with the internet is not that there is insufficient content or resources; it's that there is an over-burden of it. The process of organizing all of these resources into a designated location, making them easier to access for student communities, is essentially referred to as 'curation.'

Through the IBx Initiative, we hope to essentially solve this issue by employing curation.

The students from grades Nursery to 2 put up a beautiful cultural show for the parents which was truly a treat to the eyes.


