
E-Waste Collection Drive: A Step Towards Sustainability

By blending design thinking with real-world physics, Nova Net sparks curiosity, creativity, and a passion for innovation!










ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT Aditya Banaergi & Zaigham Hameed Butt
